

A BILL

An Act to authorise the expenditure for part of the year ending on the thirty first day of December 1991.

BE IT ENACTED by the Duli Yang Maha Mulia Seri Paduka Baginda Yang di-Pertuan Agong with the advice and consent of the Dewan Negara and Dewan Rakyat in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Consolidated Fund (Expenditure on Account) Act 1990 and shall come into force on 1st January 1991. Short title and commencement.

2. (1) In conformity with paragraph (a) of Article 102 of the Constitution, expenditure of an amount not exceeding the sum of six thousand and three million four hundred and thirty six thousand and twenty ringgit (\$6,003,436,020) to be issued from the Consolidated Fund for the service of that part of the year 1991 preceding the date of coming into force of the Supply Act in respect of that year is hereby authorised. Authorisation of expenditure of \$6,003,436,020.

(2) The amount authorised for each service in Column 1 of the Schedule shall be that specified in Column 2 thereof.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

As the Supply Bill for the year 1991 will not be passed by Parliament before 1st January 1991, it is necessary to make provision for expenditure in 1991 for the period from 1st January 1991 until the date the Supply Bill for that year becomes law and comes into force.

This Bill, pursuant to Article 102 (a) of the Constitution, seeks to authorise expenditure of an amount not exceeding six thousand and three million four hundred and thirty six thousand and twenty ringgit (\$6,003,436,020) to be issued from the Consolidated Fund for such purpose. [PN. (U²) 1644.]
