An Act to amend the Members of Parliament
(Remuneration) Act 1980.

BE IT ENACTED by the Duli Yang Maha Mulia Seri Paduka Baginda Yang di-Pertuan Agong with the advice and consent of the Dewan Negara and Dewan Rakyat in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Members of Parliament (Remuneration) (Amendment) Act 1991 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st January 1991. Short title and commencement.
2. Section 3 of the Members of Parliament Remuneration Act 1980 is amended— Amendment of section 3. Act 237.
 - (a) by inserting, immediately after the words "two thousand" in paragraph (a) of subsection (1), the words "one hundred"; and
 - (b) by inserting, immediately after the words "three thousand" in paragraph (b) of subsection (1), the words "one hundred and fifty".

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This Bill seeks to amend the Members of Parliament (Remuneration) Act 1980.

2. *Clause 2* seeks to amend section 3(1) relating to the remuneration of Members of Parliament. With this amendment Members of Parliament will receive a 5% increment in their monthly allowance with effect from the 1st January 1991. A member of the Senate will now receive a monthly allowance of \$2,100.00 and a member of the House of the Representatives \$3,150.00.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

This Bill will involve the Government in extra financial expenditure the amount of which cannot at present be ascertained.
