ADMINISTRATION OF OATH

QUESTIONS FOR ORAL ANSWERS

Tuan Hassan bin Nam: To ask the Minister of Agriculture to state:-

- (a) the total number of artificial reefs using used tyres and the names of places and States concerned;
- (b) the total number of tyres used in making these artificial reefs and the number of tyres required for eventual use; and
- (c) state the amount in pikul of catch made by the installation using artificial reefs.

Puan Hajjah Rosnah binti Haji Mohd. Salleh: To ask the Minister of National and Rural Development to state the extent of the implementation of the cottage industry.

Tuan Haji Abdul Hamid bin Haji Latiff: To ask the Prime Minister to state whether it is true that of late the racial unity in this country is at stake because of some factors. If so, what Government plans to do so that racial unity in this country really exist so that in future there should not arise unity. Whether the Government intends to reorganise the National Unity Department so that it will really function to unity all the races in this country.

Puan Hajjah Salbiah binti Mohd. Akim: To ask the Minister of Defence to state whether the Government will provide living quarters to our soldiers who are living mostly in uncomfortable rented houses in various parts of this country and that they are the frontline in safeguarding our country.

Tuan M. Sangaralingam: To ask the Minister of Education to state why only 4 places are provided to the Indian community under the UKM medical course in 1987 compared with 9 places in 1986 despite a large number of qualified Indian students and to state the reasons for not releasing the results of the public science course to the students concerned as it is the students' right to be informed of the results.

Tuan C. Krishnan: To ask the Minister of Foreign Affairs to state that the stand adopted by the Malaysian Government on the coup in Fiji.

- *7. Tuan Wong Kie Yik: To ask the Minister of Land and Regional Development to state the number of FELDA Youth Schemes established by the Government and the location of these schemes; if there is none in Sarawak, whether the Government plans to establish it in Sarawak.
- *8. Tuan Ng Peng Hay: To ask the Minister of Energy, Telecommunications and Post to state the short and long term measures taken to overcome the frequent electricity breakdowns in Malacca.
- *9. Tuan R.M. Jasni: To ask the Minister of Defence to state whether the Ministry intends to use the latest and resilient F16 Fighting Falcon aircrafts in view of the fact that three of our neighbouring countries will soon be using these aircraft.
- *10. Puan Aion Ariffin: To ask the Minister of Finance to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact of the rampant misuse of the Bumiputra name in the purchase of Sports Toto and Southern Bank shares meant for Bumiputra. If so, what action has been taken to stop such malpractice; and
 - (b) whether the CIC (Capital Investment Committee) and FIC (Foreign Investment Committee) remain silent over this malpractice.
- *11. Tuan Haji Jaafar bin Harun: To ask the Minister of Home Affairs to state the extent of the seriousness of the co-operation between the Malaysian and Indonesian police to date. What are the joint activities being carried out at present.
- *12. Tuan Dahalan bin Haji Embun: To ask the Minister of Finance to state whether it is true that foreign currencies are difficult to be brought into this country. If so, whether this will effect foreign investment in this country and tarnish the investment by Malaysians who use foreign capital as part of the equities.
- *13. Puan Norani bt. Hj. Beluah @ Hj. Hitam: To ask the Minister of Culture and Tourism to state the steps to be taken by the Ministry to beautify tourist areas found in Pahang Darul Makmur especially in Bentong Area:
- (a) Chamang waterfall;
 - (b) Lentang soothing forest;
 - (c) hot spring area at the Kuala Lumpur old road.
- *14. Puan Habidah binti Jusoh @ Yusof; To ask the Minister of Trade and Industry to state:-
- (a) why share values in Malaysia depend on trust and confidence as well as national, manipulation or foreigners in determining the appreciation and depreciation of shares; and
 - (b) can Government relax the pressure on any company which wishes to set up an industry.

- *15. Tuan Bee Yang Sek: To ask the Minister of Public Works to state:-
- (a) why the highway from Jitra to Alor Star has not been opened for public use; and
 - (b) why construction works of the highway from Gurun to Sungai Petani could not be completed.
- *16. Tuan Haji Shahrom bin Haji Masom: To ask the Minister of Information to state whether he is satisfied with the RTM programmes at present. If not, what are the measures undertaken by his Ministry to upgrade RTM programmes particularly to instil the spirit of unity and promote goodwill among the various races, When RTM will cease using the numerous languages in its programmes.
- *17. Tuan Mohd . Noor bin Bedah: To ask the Minister of Home Affairs to state the total number robberies and murders using firearms occurred throughout the country in 1986 and this year and also the measures taken to reduce or prevent it.
- *18. Puan Valli Muthusamy; To ask the Minister of Education to state since there is a large number of Malaysian students studying overseas privately, will the Government allow the private sector to establish Universities.
- *19. Tuan Shaik Dawood: To ask the Minister of Trade and Industry to state Whether his Ministry has any new plan to attract more foreign Investors to invest here.
- *20. Puan Rokiah binti Zainuddin: In ask the Minister of Culture to state the criteria to To become tourist guides and to state how many tourist guides are there in this country.
- *21. Tuan Foo Boon Liang: To ask the Minister of Culture and Tourism to state:-
- (a) the number of foreign tourists who visited our country in 1986 and what steps are taken by the Ministry to improve tourist resorts in the country especially in Pahang Darul Makmur; and
 - (b) the total amount of money spent by foreign tourists and the total amount of money in respect of advertisement spent by Government for the purpose of wooing foreign tourists to our country.
- *22. Tuan Haji Abu Bakar bin Lajim: To ask the Prime Minister to state the modernisation steps that have been and will be taken by the Ministry to upgrade the -efficiency and productivity of the Malaysian Civil Service.

- *23. Tuan Chan Chong Tak: To ask the Minister of Home Affairs to state—
CD the number of foreigners currently working in Gabah;
(ii) the estimated number of illegal immigrants in Gabah; and
(iii) what concrete steps have been taken to:
(a) reduce the number of illegal immigrants in Sabah and other parts of Malaysia; and
(b) effectively prevent the arrival of more such immigrants in the future.
- *24. Tuan Mohd. Wajdi bin Dato Haji Ishak: To ask the Minister of Transport to state and clarify on the efforts in encouraging the progress and development in Perak and it is felt that a small port he established in Perak:
(i) whether the federal Government intends to establish a small port in Lumut, Perak; and
(ii) if so, when and if not why, in view of the suitability and strategic location of Lumut,
- *25. Tuan Haji Abd. Majid bin Haji Abdullah: To ask the Minister of Energy, Telecommunications and Posts to state why after the Telecoms Department has been privatised there are still complaints received from the general public on the following aspects:
(a) high payment of bills;
(b) applications are delayed;
(c) the shortage of employees in carrying out their duties? and
(d) the vehicles have yet to be issued permit by JPJ.
- *26. Tuan Mohd. Wajdi bin Dato Haji Ishak: To ask the Minister of Agriculture to state and clarify on the steps taken or being planned by the Fisheries Department on fresh water fish especially river fish:
(i) in assuring that fresh water fish resources would not be depleted; and
(ii) in ensuring that it becomes the main delicacy of Malaysians as food.
- *27. Puan Rokiah bt. Zainuddin: To ask the Minister of Works to state the security measures taken to safe road users from:
(a) robbery at the highway;
(b) animals such as cows, buffalos and goats straying into the highways as the fences have been broken or demolished by public.

- *28. Puan Hajjah Azizah binti Haji Mohd Salleh: To ask the Prime Minister to state whether he is aware that despite the firm actions taken by the Government to instil a sense of awareness on the civil servants towards their duty and responsibility to the general public, there are still a number of the such employees who practised a negative attitude against the public. For instance the attitude and conversation shown by certain civil servants in hospitals Telecoms Department and the department which have dealings with the general public proved that they still do not understand the Barisan Nasional policy and objective.
- *29 Puan Norani binti Haji Beluah @ Haji Hitam: To ask the Minister of Health to state whether there is no planning or the part of the Ministry to elaborate the states of health sub-centres in Lancang, Pahang Darul Makmur to fully equipped Health Centres by assigning a permanent doctor, in view of the fact that at present those Health Centres have to accommodate the medical needs of more than 20,000 local people from:
- (a) 2 Felda Schemes;
 - (b) 23 Traditional Kampongs;
 - (c) 2 Chinese New Villages;
 - (d) 5 estates; and
 - (e) Lancang local Council area.
- *30. Puan Ainon Ariffin: To ask the Prime Minister to state that the rape cases are increasing amongst young women and under age children in this country, and what are the measures being taken by HAWA to participate in wiping out this crime beside the action by the authority.
- *31. Puan Habidah binti Jusoh @ Yusoff To ask the Prime Minister to state :
- (a) the number metered parking lots in Kuala Lumpur; and
 - (b) what are the benefits of using meters or manpower in looking after parking lots while our country is facing the problem of unemployment.
- *32. Tuan G. Rajoo: To ask the Minister of Foreign Affairs to state:
- (i) ASEAN's stand on the settlement of recent Kampuchea's conflict following the resignation of Prime Norodom Sihanouk; and
 - (ii) whether Malaysia will play host and take the initiative to promote an informal meeting in Kuala Lumpur between the conflicting groups in Kampuchea such as Vietnam, Democratic Kampuchea, Kampuchea, China, USA and Russia.
- *33. Tuan Hassan bin Nam: To ask the Prime Minister to state the steps and preparatory measures of each state Government with the possibility of facing floods which normally occurs in the end and early part of the year.

- *34. Tuan Tiong Hiew King; To ask the Minister of Transport to state:
- (a) whether the Government will consider to expedite the construction of Sibu new international airport in future, and
 - (b) if not, what are the measures taken to upgrade the status and to undertake repair works of the old Sibu airport to facilitate landing by big air craft.
- *35. Dato' Dr. K.S. Nijhar: To ask the Minister of Science, Technology and environment to state whether he is satisfied with the method of disposal and facilities to process waste materials in towns. What measures have been taken to ensure that there will be no side-effect on public health and environment,
- *36. Tuan Paramjit Singh: To ask the Minister of Defence to state:-
- (a) what steps has the Government taken to ensure that there would be no further intrusion into Malaysia territory by members of the Singapore armed force; and
 - (b) what action has the Singapore Government taken against the soldiers who intruded into the Malaysian territory.
