QUESTIONS FOR ORAL ANSWERS

1. **Dato' Haji Arzmi bin Haji Abdul Hamid** to ask the **MINISTER OF HIGHER EDUCATION** to state that university students on 3 months holiday have no suitable program to keep them occupied during the holiday.
2. **Dato' Dr. Chin Fook Weng** to ask the **MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS** to state whether Malaysia's foreign policy on Thailand is appropriate since whenever problems occurred in Southern Thailand, Malaysia seems to be implicated for providing shelter as well as training to Thai terrorists to the point that the Deputy Prime Minister went to Thailand to meet the Thai Prime Minister.
3. **Puan Ooi Siew Kim** to ask the **MINISTER OF HEALTH** to state the action taken on the complaints received from patients having to wait a long time before they can get specialist treatment at general hospitals.
4. **Puan Hajah Sharifah Azizah binti Dato' Syed Zain** to ask the **PRIME MINISTER** to state that the country were shocked by the statement of chairman of Islamic Understanding Institute on the declining Muslim marriage rates. The Institute is worried about this trend. The action taken to arrest this problem.
5. **Puan Wan Ubaidah binti Omar** to ask the **MINISTER OF ENERGY, WATER AND COMMUNICATIONS** to state the means to ban the pornographic websites at national level.
6. **Datuk Kalakau @ Kalakan bin Untol** to ask the **MINISTER OF INTERNAL SECURITY** to state that there are many district police headquarters buildings that are cramped and require renovation or additional building to operate efficiently such as the Sentul Police headquarters.

7. **Datuk Hajah Hazizah binti Mohd. Sultan** to ask the **PRIME MINISTER** to state the reason the time taken for court to proceed with cases and resulting in difficulty for cases to be tried. Only high profile cases with wide publicity will be tried quickly while the others have their cases postponed.
8. **Datuk Syed Ali bin Tan Sri Syed Abbas Alhabshee** to ask the **MINISTER OF HEALTH** to state whether the objective of the say no to smoking will be achieved since many refused to give up and ignored the no smoking zone.
9. **Dato' Lim Sing @ Lam Kam Sang** to ask the **MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND AGRO-BASED INDUSTRY** to state the plan in the immediate future to ensure the success of agro-based industry in the east coast of the Peninsula.
10. **Tuan Osman bin Bungsu** to ask the **MINISTER OF HEALTH** to state the intention to review the terms for disbursing the ministry's fund to needy patients suffering from chronic diseases.
11. **Tuan Lee Sing Chooi** to ask the **MINISTER OF FEDERAL TERRITORIES** to state the main problems faced by residents, especially the youths of Labuan and the action to help them.
12. **Tuan Ismail bin Kasim** to ask the **MINISTER OF FINANCE** to state whether the government intends to continue with the direct negotiation method for companies that have good records, and if not, whether the limited tender system is fair to all concerned especially to companies with good track records.
13. **Tuan Haji Hassan bin Haji Shukri** to ask the **MINISTER OF YOUTH AND SPORTS** to state the list of registered youth associations led by leaders who are more than 45 years old.
14. **Tuan Krishnan a/l Maniam** to ask the **MINISTER OF HOUSING AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT** to state the effectiveness of the rent and buy concept for low- cost houses and whether it will be extended to estate workers nationwide.
15. **Dato' Haji Muhammad bin Haji Abdul Ghani** to ask the **MINISTER OF DEFENCE** to state the reason armed forces personnel resigned without pension and the way to prevent this.

16. **Tuan Poh Mok Hua @ Poh Bak Hoe** to ask the **MINISTER OF EDUCATION** to state:-
  - (a) the number of capital-aid secondary schools nationwide for 2003 and those who have received the grant; and
  - (b) the amount disbursed according to type.
17. **Tuan Tan Cheng Tee** to ask the **MINISTER OF INTERNATIONAL TRADE AND INDUSTRY** to state the number of foreign-owned companies that have relocated outside Malaysia and the for doing so.
18. **Datuk Mansor bin Haji Md. Jaafar** to ask the **PRIME MINISTER** to state the progress on the application by the armed forces for additional allowances, and if any of it has been approved, whether it will be extended to other uniform units such as the Police, Customs, Immigration, Fire Department and others that have its own service characteristic.
19. **Puan Jaya Partiban** to ask the **MINISTER OF WOMEN, FAMILY AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT** to state the programmes to enhance the family institution and measure to include all races to participate.
20. **Tuan Lee Sing Chooi** to ask the **MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCES** to state the number of industrial disputes referred to the Ministry from 2000-2004. The number solved, and action taken to solve the postponed cases.
21. **Dato' Dr. Vijayaratnam a/l Seevaratnam** to ask the **MINISTER OF HIGHER EDUCATION** to state the action taken to minimize racial polarization at public institutions of higher learning.
22. **Tuan Wan Nordin bin Che Murat** to ask the **MINISTER OF WOMEN, FAMILY AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT** to state the reason for the proliferation of reports on the hardship and suffering of the poor by the print and electronic media. Whether monitoring is done and reason for the aids not reaching the poor.
23. **Dato' Lim Sing @ Lam Kam Sang** to ask the **MINISTER OF DEFENCE** to state the causes of fighting and indiscipline among National Service trainees and action taken to address the problem.
24. **Tuan Lee Sing Chooi** to ask the **MINISTER OF INTERNAL SECURITY** to state the study done on how to deter and wipe out snatch thefts that seems to be getting serious and the extent action is taken based on the study.

25. **Dato' Dr. Chin Fook Weng** to ask the **MINISTER OF RURAL AND REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT** to state the programme to eradicate rural poverty in the northern states of Penang, Kedah and Perlis.
26. **Dato' Lim Sing @ Lam Kam Sang** to ask the **MINISTER OF DOMESTIC TRADE AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS** to state the government decision in approving price increase for steel- iron can provide the solution to supply and demand in the market.
27. **Dato' Dr. Vijayaratnam a/l Seevaratnam** to ask the **MINISTER OF FEDERAL TERRITORIES** to state the intention to prevent vehicles from entering the city center without paying fees so as to reduce traffic congestion in Kuala Lumpur.
28. **Puan Ooi Siew Kim** to ask the **MINISTER OF DEFENCE** to state the reason for the many untoward incidents reported during the National Service training programme. Whether this programme can foster national unity.
29. **Tuan Wan Nordin bin Che Murat** to ask the **MINISTER OF FINANCE** to state the action taken to ensure that financial institutions will give applicants the opportunity to submit CTOS 's record showing that all dues have been settled and to consider cases where the applicants have good track record. Whether there are guidelines on this matter.
30. **Puan Wan Ubaidah binti Omar** to ask the **MINISTER OF FINANCE** to state the performance of the Malaysian Stock Exchange after the demutualisation.
31. **Dato' Haji Muhammad bin Haji Abdul Ghani** to ask the **MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCES** to state the measures to be taken to assist unemployed graduates to get jobs suited to their qualifications and the effectiveness of the schemes to help the unemployed.
32. **Tuan Haji Hassan bin Haji Shukri** to ask the **MINISTER OF RURAL AND REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT** to state the financial allocations given to the Hardcore Poor Development Projects from 1995- 2003 according to states.
33. **Tuan Saravanan a/l Murugan** to ask the **MINISTER OF HOUSING AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT** to state the success in eradicating squatters areas before 2005. The number of squatters on government reserves and private land.

34. **Puan Hajah Che Jam binti Harun** to ask the **PRIME MINISTER** to state that government servants who opted to retire on Scheme B failed to name their beneficiaries. There are cases of retirees suffering from comatose from months to years having their pension stopped due to the failure to fill in the forms at the banks while still alive and whether certification from doctor is adequate.
35. **Puan Siw Chun a/l Eam** to ask the **MINISTER OF ENERGY, WATER AND COMMUNICATIONS** to state the monitoring done and action taken against users who misused the websites to spread false information, lies and allegation about national leaders till 2003.
36. **Puan Hajah Sharifah Azizah binti Dato' Syed Zain** to ask the **MINISTER OF FINANCE** to state:-
- (a) whether it is a stated condition that Class F contractors will receive payment based on their quotation or the possibility that payment can be based on the quality of their work; and
  - (b) the measures to ease the problem of the contractors.
37. **Puan Hajah Che Jam binti Harun** to ask the **MINISTER OF INTERNAL SECURITY** to state :-
- (a) the supervision done on juvenile delinquents after their release from Henry Gurney center and the type of training given to the juveniles to assist them in agricultural pursuit; and
  - (b) whether the supervision is done by an internal committee of the ministry to determine the effectiveness of the center and to prevent the juveniles from going back to their old ways.
38. **Puan Wan Ubaidah binti Omar** to ask the **MINISTER OF HEALTH** to state the intention to make it compulsory for couples getting married to undergo blood test to show that they are free of HIV as the couple will be aware of the risk they are taking.
39. **Tuan Haji Hassan bin Haji Shukri** to ask the **MINISTER OF INTERNAL SECURITY** to state the list of criminal gangs busted from 1999-2003 and the members for each gang.
40. **Tuan Saravanan a/l Murugan** to ask the **PRIME MINISTER** to state the progress in the effort to increase the equity holding of the Indians, as set out in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Outline Perspective Plan (2001-2010), from 1.5% to 3% .

41. **Puan Siti Zailah binti Mohd. Yusoff** to ask the **PRIME MINISTER** to state the rationale for not setting up a royal commission of inquiry to investigate wrong doings, malpractices as well as unfairness by the Election Commission during the 11<sup>th</sup> General Election campaign.
42. **Datuk Yaakob bin Haji Mohammad** to ask the **PRIME MINISTER** to state:-
- (a) the measures and strategy taken by the Public Service Department to ensure in promotion and transfer exercise of senior government officers are carried out properly without any negative implication from the administrative, political and officers' morale stand point; and
  - (b) the number of senior government officers still serving on contract basis according to ministry and department and the criteria for extending their services.
43. **Dato' Haji Muhammad bin Haji Abdul Ghani** to ask the **MINISTER OF HIGHER EDUCATION** to state whether the ministry intends to revive certificate and diploma courses previously conducted by Institut Teknologi MARA before it became UiTM so as to enable bumiputera students to follow the courses.
44. **Tuan Osman bin Bungsu** to ask the **MINISTER OF FINANCE** to state the rationale for reducing the development allocation from RM115 millions to RM40 millions that is meant to eradicate hardcore poverty, implement development program, provide infrastructure and educational facility to the Orang Asli students.
