ADMINISTRATION OF OATH

QUESTIONS FOR ORAL ANSWERS

1. **Dato' Hamzah bin Zainudin** to ask the **PRIME MINISTER** to state which authority is responsible for recognition of foreign universities and whether the Public Service Department (PSD) is in contact with the universities before any students are sponsored to further their studies to ensure that there will be no recognition problem after the students have completed their studies.
2. **Datuk William Lau Kung Hui** to ask the **MINISTER OF FINANCE** to state the pressure on Ringgit compared to Euro and Dollar Australia for the past 6 months due to Ringgit being pegged to US Dollar and whether this situation will affect the stability of national economy. Whether the Ministry has any plan to un-pegged Ringgit or to review it.
3. **Tuan Saravanan a/l Murugan** to ask the **MINISTER OF DOMESTIC TRADE AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS** to state the action plan taken by the Ministry to help the local manufacturing companies which are facing losses due to the increase in the price of iron for the past one year.
4. **Datuk Syed Ali bin Tan Sri Syed Abbas Alhabshee** to ask the **MINISTER OF HEALTH** to state why the Ministry did not take the initiative to transfer chronic patients from private hospitals to Government hospitals especially for cases that needs high treatment cost and for families who are unable to bear the cost.

5. **Puan Siti Zailah binti Mohd. Yusoff** to ask the **MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND AGRO-BASED INDUSTRY** to state the the comprehensive measures taken to reduce the high imports of food products.
6. **Datuk Mansor bin Haji Md. Jaafar** to ask the **MINISTER OF WOMEN, FAMILY AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT** to state the action taken by the Ministry to stop more Malay women from working as GRO in entertainment outlets and the measures taken to help them from being involved in this profession.
7. **Tuan Poh Mok Hua @ Poh Bak Hoe** to ask the **MINISTER OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENT** to state the short and long term measures to tackle the haze problem.
8. **Datuk Hajah Hazizah binti Mohd. Sultan** to ask the **MINISTER OF ENERGY, WATER AND COMMUNICATIONS** to state whether the Ministry has any plan to stop the screening of wrestling for public through TV3 as it can influence and affect the viewer especially the youth.
9. **Dato' Haji Arzmi bin Haji Abdul Hamid** to ask the **MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS** to state to state the best action to stop or control the influx of illegal immigrants where an estimate of 1.2 million is in Malaysia and their presence is threatening our national security.
10. **Tuan Osman bin Bungsu** to ask the **MINISTER OF ENTREPRENEUR AND COOPERATIVE DEVELOPMENT** to state the number of successful entrepreneurs in various fields and the plan to increase their professionalism, for example, in Information Technology and Multimedia for competitive career opportunities.
11. **Puan Hajah Che Jam binti Harun** to ask the **MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCES** to state:-
 - (a) list all types of training skills provided by the Ministry for unemployed youths and whether these training is well coordinated to ensure easy access to the training programme, and
 - (b) whether the Government is aware that many disabled failed to get jobs in the Government department and agencies even though they have relevant qualifications. If this is true, whether the Ministry has any plan to help these people.
12. **Puan Wan Ubaidah binti Omar** to ask the **MINISTER OF WOMEN, FAMILY AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT** to state whether there are any cases of "gay" and "lesbians" referred to the Government and the effort to curb these social illness from spreading in the country.

13. **Tuan Udam @ George Adam bin Talek** minta to ask the **MINISTER OF DOMESTIC TRADE AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS** to state the Ministry's action to ensure that the price of necessity goods will not increase as the result of the recent petroleum price increase.
14. **Puan Jaya Partiban** to ask the **MINISTER OF CULTURE, ARTS AND HERITAGE** to state the measures taken to ensure that the multiracial people in this country really understands the culture and tradition of each race.
15. **Tuan Zainal bin Rampak** to ask the **MINISTER OF FINANCE** to state why the local banking institute are imposing an additional charge on the service such as individual cash cheques (RM2.00) company cheques (RM5.00) and ATM transaction (RM0.50). These charges are a burden to customers and may hinder the Government's call for the public to save.
16. **Datuk Benedict Bujang Tembak** to ask the **MINISTER OF HIGHER EDUCATION** to state whether the Ministry strictly applied the meritocracy system in choosing the candidates for local universities this year. If so, state the number of application from the rural areas of Sarawak are rejected.
17. **Tuan Ismail bin Kasim** to ask the **MINISTER OF TRANSPORT** to state the action taken on the ever increasing number of vehicles throughout a year and the drastic measures taken on old vehicles on the road.
18. **Puan Siw Chun a/p Eam** to ask the **MINISTER OF INTERNAL SECURITY** to state:-
 - (a) the number of sexual crime cases that takes place in public areas, involving the public and incest up to June 2004; and
 - (b) the judiciary action taken on those criminals.
19. **Dato' Omar bin Faudzar** to ask the **MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS** to state whether the Government has any intention to limit the influx of foreign immigrants according to the increase of foreign workers in the construction sector.
20. **Puan Hajah Wan Ramlah binti Ahmad** to ask the **MINISTER OF EDUCATION** to state the Ministry's plan to coordinate the post for graduate Headmaster / Headmistress in primary schools to balance against the intake of graduate senior assistant .

21. **Tuan Haji Hassan bin Haji Shukri** to ask the **MINISTER OF HOUSING AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT** to state the preparation made by the Government along with Malaysian Architect (PAM) Association and Malaysian Engineering Institute (IEM) in considering the implementation of abolishing Certificate of Fitness (CF) especially in terms of safety and quality of the houses.
22. **Puan Hajah Samsiah binti Samsudin** to ask the **MINISTER OF EDUCATION** to state the rationale for changing the name of the Ministry in Bahasa Melayu from “Pendidikan” to “Pelajaran”, although the meaning of “Pendidikan” is more comprehensive.
23. **Datuk Mansor bin Haji Md. Jaafar** to ask the **PRIME MINISTER** to state to what extent the monitoring effort, investigation and action taken by the Government on illegal immigrants that are bringing in and practicing deviations of Islamic teachings. State the number of deviationist group identified and those charged and the type of punishment.
24. **Dato' Haji Arzmi bin Haji Abdul Hamid** to ask the **MINISTER OF WOMEN, FAMILY AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT** to state as many girls from Kelantan (13,000) reported to have become GRO in the Klang Valley. State whether this is true, if so, what is the cause, whether due to poverty, no jobs opening or other factors.
25. **Tuan Osman bin Bungsu** to ask the **PRIME MINISTER** to state :-
 - (a) the number of Malaysian students on Government Scholarship studying abroad according to race; and
 - (b) the criteria of special recognition by the Ministry to enable the students to get this scholarship.
26. **Tuan Wan Nordin bin Che Murat** to ask the **MINISTER OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENT** to state the action taken to overcome the haze problem that occurs too frequently in our country. State the cooperation between the Government with the neighbouring country to help control open burning of forest areas.
27. **Puan Safinah binti Jusoh** to ask the **PRIME MINISTER** to state whether the Government has plan to review Poverty Level for the Peninsular, Sabah and Sarawak in order to take into consideration the current national and international development especially the rising cost of living.
28. **Tuan Haji Hassan bin Haji Shukri** to ask the **MINISTER OF FINANCE** to state the factor that contributes to the increase of national debts for 2003 in comparison to 2002 , and the plan proposed by National Economic Action Council (NEAC) to balance the debts with Gross Domestic Products (GDP).

29. **Dato' Lim Sing @ Lam Kam Sang** to ask the **MINISTER OF FINANCE** to state:-
- (a) the extent of measures taken to educate individual tax payers to make personal assessment of income tax has succeeded; and
 - (b) whether the Government will introduce electronic tax payment system in line with the development of e-Government.
30. **Tuan Tan Cheng Tee** to ask the **MINISTER OF SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY AND INNOVATIONS** to state the extent of the action taken by the min to improve the national technology capabilities in comparison to other ASEAN countries especially Singapore.
31. **Dato' Haji Muhammad bin Haji Abdul Ghani** to ask the **MINISTER OF WORKS** to state the reason that cause MR2 Elevated Highway to sink, whether it is due to geological reasons or whether there is an element of human carelessness and mismanagement.
32. **Tuan Wilson Sagamani a/l Paul Devasagayam** to ask the **MINISTER OF YOUTH AND SPORTS** to state the breakdown of active Bumiputera and non-Bumiputera youth entrepreneurs and the reason identified for their failure; the measures taken to help these entrepreneurs and whether this method is beneficial and effective.
33. **Datin Hajah Puizah @ Faezah binti Haji Abu Kassim** to ask the **MINISTER OF ENTREPRENEUR AND COOPERATIVE DEVELOPMENT** to state the explain the necessity for TEKUN loan as it has elements of riba' even though it is used to help new petty traders.
34. **Puan Hajah Che Jam binti Harun** to ask the **MINISTER OF TRANSPORT** to state whether the Ministry will continue the usage of black box for busses and lorries in the effort to reduce accidents. If so, whether there is a method of inspection to ensure that the black box is in working condition or otherwise.
35. **Dato' Dr. Vijayaratnam a/l Seevaratnam** to ask the **MINISTER OF EDUCATION** to state the development of an investigation made on a school that allegedly allows the selling of ruler that has a political party's logo at the bookshop.

36. **Tuan Chiam Yong Tee** to ask the **MINISTER OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENT** to state:-
- a) the plans implemented to ensure that our rivers are not polluted; and
 - b) the number of cases on river pollution brought to court.
37. **Tuan Wan Nordin bin Che Murat** to ask the **MINISTER OF DOMESTIC TRADE AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS** to state the action taken to ensure that imported “halal” food bears the Government issued halal logo, as there are imported “halal” food from China and Thailand with dubious “halal” logo. The action taken against those using unauthorized halal logo for their food products.
38. **Tuan Lee Sing Chooi** to ask the **MINISTER OF EDUCATION** to state the efforts to uplift the spirit of students from national, Chinese and Tamil national type schools who are weak in their studies and the effectiveness of the efforts.
39. **Datuk Syed Ali bin Tan Sri Syed Abbas Alhabshee** to ask the **MINISTER OF INTERNAL SECURITY** to state the film censorship procedure to classify excessive violent movies as they are being screened in cinemas throughout Malaysia. Excessive violent movies have negative impact on youths and influenced the individual to commit crimes while the Government is trying to reduce the crime rates.
40. **Tuan Lee Sing Chooi** to ask the **MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS** to state the number of Malaysians according to race who resides in other countries, the list of countries with a high number of Malaysians and the number of Malaysians according to race in each country listed. The contribution made by Malaysians in the foreign countries.
41. **Dato' Lim Sing @ Lam Kam Sang** to ask the **MINISTER OF HEALTH** to state the number of NGOs that have received financial aids from the Ministry and the conditions to be fulfilled before submitting the application for the aids.
42. **Datuk Hajah Hazizah binti Mohd. Sultan** to ask the **MINISTER OF DEFENCE** to state the efforts by the Government with the cooperation of countries within the region to ensure that the Straits of Malacca is free from pirates and terrorists' threats.
43. **Puan Mariah binti Haji Abdullah** to ask the **MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS** to state the extent the Government are able to control the influx of foreign workers into the country that denies the locals of their right to employment.

44. **Puan Ooi Siew Kim** to ask the **MINISTER OF HOUSING AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT** to state why there are many complaints on the local Government unable to provide the best service. State the action taken by the Ministry to tackle this problem.
45. **Dato' Haji Muhammad bin Haji Abdul Ghani** to ask the **MINISTER OF ENTREPRENEUR AND COOPERATIVE DEVELOPMENT** to state the whether the Ministry has any intention to allow former military or police personnel to apply for taxi permits.
46. **Puan Mariah binti Haji Abdullah** to ask the **MINISTER OF EDUCATION** to state the extent of the effort taken by the Government to tackle truancy among students and those wasting their time in video entertainment outlets and shopping complexes.
47. **Tuan Haji Hassan bin Haji Shukri** to ask the **MINISTER OF HIGHER EDUCATION** to state the losses suffered by local universities due to vandalism acts by previous National Service trainees.
48. **Tuan Wilson Sagamani a/l Paul Devasagayam** to ask the **MINISTER OF HOUSING AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT** to state whether the Government is aware of the difference between plantation workers and illegal squatters as they are grouped together in their allocation to low cost houses; and whether the Government will consider to differentiate them in channeling financial aids including low cost houses according to their status and contribution to the development.
49. **Dato' Ikhwan Salim bin Dato' Haji Sujak** to ask the **MINISTER OF HOUSING AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT** to state short and long term measures taken by the Ministry to ensure that the low cost houses that are difficult to sell are sold.
50. **Dato' Ratnam a/l Muthiah** to ask the **MINISTER OF EDUCATION** to state when the Ministry will formulate a special plan to change capital aided Tamil schools to fully aided schools as these schools are lagging behind in term of facilities and infrastructure. If not, why.
51. **Dato' Haji Muhammad bin Haji Abdul Ghani** to ask the **MINISTER OF INTERNAL SECURITY** to state the action taken by the Ministry to stop drug addicts from finding cheaper and easily available alternative such as ketum leaves, gum, cow dung, cough medicine and cannabis.
52. **Datuk Syed Ali bin Tan Sri Syed Abbas Alhabshee** to ask the **MINISTER OF EDUCATION** to state the next course of action taken by the Ministry following the arrest made on students who were found loafing in cyber cafes during and after school hours.

53. **Datuk Yaakob bin Haji Mohammad** to ask the **MINISTER OF INTERNAL SECURITY** to state:-
- (a) the number of prisoners in jail according to race, sex, age and the period of detention including for foreign nationals to date; and
 - (b) the cost borne by the Government.
54. **Puan Jaya Partiban** to ask the **MINISTER OF HEALTH** to state whether the Ministry intends to set up a special committee with Ministry of Information to monitor health related advertisement to ensure that that the public will not be easily influenced.
55. **Tuan Wan Nordin bin Che Murat** to ask the **PRIME MINISTER** to state actions taken by JAKIM to disseminate clear concept of Islam Hadhari as the recent win of Barisan Nasional is based on the public trust of the concept, but there are a number who are not clear of this concept.
56. **Puan Mariah binti Haji Abdullah** to ask the **MINISTER OF WOMEN, FAMILY AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT** to state measures to be taken to increase the number of registered counselors to handle various cases including mental health.
57. **Dato' Ikhwan Salim bin Dato' Haji Sujak** to ask the **MINISTER OF HOUSING AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT** to state the value of abandoned low cost housing projects, the role and action taken by Syarikat Perumahan Negara (SPN) to solve this problem.
58. **Datuk Mansor bin Haji Md. Jaafar** to ask the **MINISTER OF HIGHER EDUCATION** to state whether the Ministry has a regulatory system to determine the method, standardization and monitoring scope on course content and marking system practiced in public and private institutions of higher learning to avoid the possibility of "favoritism" among the supervisors and examiners when they are allowed to use their own discretion.
59. **Puan Nosimah binti Hashim** to ask the **MINISTER OF INFORMATION** to state whether the Ministry will determine high quality of drama and to ensure that local films and TV dramas will portray more Islamic elements and moral values.

60. **Dato' Dr. Chin Fook Weng** to ask the **PRIME MINISTER** to state the action taken to strengthen the confidence of the people on the judiciary system as there are still a lot of questions on the appointment, promotions and quality of the judges.
61. **Tuan Krishnan a/l Maniam** to ask the **MINISTER OF HEALTH** to state the action taken to ensure that the equipment and basic facilities in clinics in plantation areas are in good condition to achieve "Zero Defect" so that the plantation workers will be able to get the best medical service.
62. **Che Puan Kelana D'Raja Datin (Dr) Hajah Nik Azizah Binti Haji Nik Yahya** to ask the **MINISTER OF WOMEN, FAMILY AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT** to state the action taken and will be taken by the Ministry to resolve the snatch-theft and robbery cases which are becoming more serious today in view of three deaths which occurred following the incidents.
63. **Datin Naomi Chong Set Mui** to ask the **MINISTER OF TRANSPORT** to state whether the Ministry will encourage Singapore Airlines to continue its direct flight to Kota Kinabalu in order to attract more Singaporeans coming to visit Sabah as the country is an international tourist hub.
64. **Dato' Ikhwan Salim bin Dato' Haji Sujak** to ask the **MINISTER OF FINANCE** to state whether the dividend announced by EPF recently will be maintained in future and whether other incentives will be introduced due to better performance of EPF this year.

Dewan ini melahirkan rasa kesal dengan penggunaan istilah-istilah asing seperti perkataan "precint" di Putrajaya sehingga menjejaskan kedudukan Putrajaya sebagai Pusat Pentadbiran Kerajaan Persekutuan yang berjiwa kebangsaan yang merdeka dan berdaulat. Kerajaan sepatutnya memastikan bahasa kebangsaan didahulukan dalam semua penggunaan, kecuali jika tidak terdapat perkataan bahasa Melayu atau bahasa serumpun, barulah wajar bahasa asing digunakan. Dewan ini juga sangat kesal dengan kecuaiannya Kerajaan dalam mendaulatkan bahasa Kebangsaan di pusat pentadbiran itu sehingga menjadi galakan yang boleh merosakkan bahasa Kebangsaan".
