QUESTIONS FOR ORAL ANSWERS

- *1. Enche' V.David: To ask the Minister of Works, Posts and Telecommunications to state the cost of printing the Telephone Directory for July, 1962, and the amount of revenue derived from advertisements appearing in the Directory.
- *2. Enche' V.David: To ask the Deputy Prime Minister whether the R.I.D.A. has incurred any financial loss up to 30th June, 1962, by subsidising building contractors, and, if so, how much.
- *3. Enche' V.David: To ask the Minister of Internal Security to state the number of expatriate police officers in the Police Department, and why posts occupied by these expatriates have not been Malayanised.
