\*1. Enche' C.V. Devan Nair: To ask the Minister of Works, Posts and Telecommunications to state why it was necessary for the former Director of Public Works to be made an "Adviser" to the present Malayan Director:

\*4. Enche' Abang Othman bin. Abang Haji Moasili: To ask the Minister of Health to state the action taken so far, regarding the construction of New Hospital in Kuching costing \$13 million.
