Questions for Oral Answers

- *1. Dr. Tan Chee Khoon: To ask the Minister of Commerce and Industry to state the necessity for restricting the import of sugar on 11th June, 1964 when local sugar mills would only be able to produce less than half the amount of sugar consumed in this country and that too not earlier than October, 1964.
- *2. Dr. Tan Chee Khoon: To ask the Minister of Commerce and Industry to state whether he has made any representations to the United States Government over the dumping of tin from the United States stock-pile, if so what assurances he has got from that country to enable our tin industry to get a fair price for our produce.
- *3. Dato' Haji Mustafa bin Haji Abdul Jabar: To ask the Minister of Education to state if Government proposes to build Comprehensive Schools in the district of Sabak Bernam and, if so, the number of such schools to be built, when construction will be started and the areas where they will be built.
- *4. Abang Othman bin Haji Moasili: To ask the Minister for Welfare Services to state if Government will grant financial aid to the Association for the Blind in Sarawak.
