QUESTIONS FOR ORAL ANSWERS

*1. Enche' V. David: To ask the Minister of Commerce and Industry whether the Federation Government supported the appointment of Mr. P.F. Adams to the International Rubber Study Group, and whether Mr. Adams was a former official of the Government who left with Malayanisation Compensation.

*2. Enche' V. David: To ask the Minister of Commerce and Industry whether the Government is in favour of the Common Market proposed by the Singapore Government and what progress has been made on this matter.

*3. Enche' V. David: To ask the Minister of Commerce and Industry whether any British Company has made representation against a fertilizer factory on a co-operative basis.

*4. Enche' Ahmad bin Arshad: To ask the Minister of Education whether it is a fact that since 1951 the people of Bukit Gambir, Muar, Johore, have appealed to the Government to build a girls' school for the 335 girls in that locality who at present are being accommodated in the Boys' School in the afternoon, and, if so, whether Government intends to build the school and when.
