QUESTIONS FOR ORAL ANSWERS

\*1. Enche' Ahmad bin Arshad: To ask the Minister of Commerce and Industry to state whether, in order to attract tourists to this country, the Government intends to develop Gunong Ledang in Johore which at present is frequented by the public on week-ends, into a tourist centre, and, if not, whether Government will assist any individual or concern wishing to develop it.

\*2. Enche' Ahmad bin Arshad: To ask the Minister of Finance to state whether Government is aware that a large number of people in this country smoke opium which they can obtain illegally and, if so, the steps being taken to stop this.

\*3. Enche' Ahmad bin Arshad: To ask the Minister of Health and Social Welfare to state whether it is a fact that many Muslim children are placed under the care of Christian missionary bodies in this country and, if so, the steps being taken to remove these children from such bodies and place them under the care of Muslims.

\*4. Enche' V. David: To ask the Minister of Agriculture and Co-operatives to state whether it is the Government's policy to encourage the establishment of a fertilizer factory on a co-operative basis, and if it is so, what aid is Government giving to the project.

\*5. Enche' V. David: To ask the Deputy Prime Minister whether RIDA appointments need sanction from the Public Services Commission, and under what conditions was Mr. Acton, formerly of Carrier airconditioning company, employed by the RIDA and also what are his functions in the Authority, what qualifications does he have for the post and were attempts made to get a local man.

\*6. Enche' V. David: To ask the Deputy Prime Minister the name of the firm which printed the rural Development Plan books (bukumerah), how many were printed, the cost of each book and whether tenders were called for the printing.
