At the Commencement of Public Business

"Business" Motions

1. The Prime Minister to move -

That at its rising this day the House do stand adjourned to Monday the 6th February, 1961.

2. The Prime Minister to move -

That, notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 12, the House shall not adjourn this day until after the completion of all Government Business on the Order Paper.

Order of the Day and Notices of Motions

1. Resumption of Consideration of the Provisional Development Estimates, 1961 (Cmd. 60 of 1960) in Committee of the whole House (21st December, 1960).

2. The Minister of Finance to move:

That this House resolves that in accordance with the powers vested in it by virtue of sub-section (2) of Section 10 of the Customs Ordinance, 1952, the Customs Duties (Amendment) (No.4) Order 1960, which has been laid before the House as Statute Paper No. 60 of 1960, be confirmed.

3. Motion made by Dato Onn bin Ja'afar and Question proposed -

That the Rupabangsa or Nationality of the Persekutuan Tanah Melayu shall be known as "Melayu". Resumption of Debate on Question (2nd December, 1960).

4. Enche Zulkiflee bin Muhammad to move:

This House is deeply concerned at the late submission by the Government to the Auditor-General of the statement required under section 16 of the Financial Procedure Ordinance, 1957, vide Report of the Acting Auditor-General tabled as Command Paper No. 36 of 1960.

5. Dato' Mohammad Hanifah bin Haji Abdul Ghani to move:

That legislation be introduced to prohibit the employment of non-Federal Citizens in Government Departments and in commercial and industrial firms in the Federation, provided, however, that skilled workers who are not Federal Citizens may be employed for a limited period.
