Questions for Oral Answers

- \*1. Enche' K. Karam Singh: To ask the Minister of Agriculture and Co-operatives to give the number of fishermen adversely affected by piracy in the Malacca Straits and to state the steps the Government has taken to enable these displaced fishermen to carry on their work.
- \*2. Enche' K. Karam Singh: To ask the Minister of Agriculture and Co-operatives to state what relief measures the Government has taken in this matter.

Orders of the Day and Notices of Motions

1. (DR.37/63) The Supply Bill 1964 - Resumption of Debate on the Question "That the Bill be now read a second time" (21st December, 1963).

2. The Minister of Finance to move:

That this House resolves that a sum not exceeding \$721,587,720 be expended out of the Development Fund in the year 1964, and that to meet the purposes of the Heads and Sub-heads set out in the second column of the Statement laid on the Table as Command Paper No. 46 of 1963, there be appropriated the sums specified against such Heads and Sub-heads in the ninth and tenth columns in respect of Heads 100-153 and the eighth and ninth columns in respect of Heads 155-210.

3. The Minister of Finance to move:

That, in accordance with the provisions of Sub-section (4) of Section 10 of the Financial Procedure Ordinance, 1957, the Second Schedule to the said Ordinance be amended by adding thereto the following new item:

"The Fishermen's Rehabilitation Fund"

4. Dato Mohamed Hanifah bin Haji Abdul Ghani to move:

That this House condemns the Central Government for the abuse of its powers under the Internal Security Act in detaining recently an Islamic religious teacher in Kelantan and demands that the teacher concerned be released and that no Islamic religious teacher should be detained because of his religious views.

5. Tuan Haji Hasan Adli bin Haji Arshad to move:

That Government should introduce legislation for the formation of a National Cultural Council.

6. Enche' V. David to move:

This House calls upon the Government to replace the Federal Capital Act by a fully elected Municipal Council for Kuala Lumpur.

7. Enche' Lim Huan Boon to move:

That this House condemns the Central Government for its abuse of powers under the Internal Security Act in carrying out the recent arrests and detentions of political and trade union leaders and demands that they be unconditionally released forthwith or be brought for trial in a court of law.
