MEDIA STATEMENT ON THE PROCEEDING ON THE DEVELOPMENT AND PROCUREMENT OF THE MYSEJAHTERA APPLICATION

- 1. The Public Accounts Committee (PAC) on 21.04.2022 continued with the proceeding on the Development and Procurement of the MySejahtera Application by hearing the statements and explanations from the three agencies under the Prime Minister's Department (JPM), namely the Malaysian Administrative Modernisation and Management Planning Unit (MAMPU), the Malaysian National Security Council (MKN), and the National Cyber Security Agency (NACSA).
- 2. JPM was represented by Datuk Sollehuddin Alyubi bin Zakaria, Deputy Secretary-General (Finance and Development) and Deputy Secretary-General (Management), Datuk Mohamad bin Ismail. Meanwhile, the other three agencies' representatives were MAMPU Director-General, Datuk Seri Dr. Yusoff bin Ismail, MKN Director-General, Datuk Rodzi bin Md Saad, and NACSA Chief Executive, Rahamzan bin Hashim.
- 3. This second proceeding was held after the first proceeding on 14 April which was attended by the Minister of Finance, Datuk Seri Tengku Zafrul Tengku Abdul Aziz and the Minister of Health, Khairy Jamaluddin.

- 4. The three hours proceeding that started at 10 a.m. focused on the:
- i. The parties involved in appointing KPISoft Sdn. Bhd. to develop the MySejahtera application in April 2020;
- ii. The continuity of the proposed CSR (corporate social responsibility) concept;
- iii. The absence of the Formal Contract between the Government and the developer's company;
- iv. The ownership of the MySejahtera application, specifically its intellectual property and the stance of KPISoft Sdn. Bhd. and/or MySj Sdn. Bhd. on the intellectual property ownership claims as stated in court documents and related documents.
 - 5. The PAC will scrutinise all the statements and explanations, documents, and minutes of meetings obtained and will decide whether to summon more witnesses or not.
 - 6. The PAC will table its Report in the House of Representatives in the first week when the Parliament reconvenes on 18.07.2022. As these proceedings involved a very crucial issue, the PAC urges the Speaker to allow this Report to be debated in the House of Representatives for at least one (1) day.
 - 7. The PAC also suggests that the Government takes into consideration the recommendations in the PAC Report that will be tabled in the House of Representatives and the views of the Members of Parliament before making any decision that will have financial implications in regard to the issue of the Development of the MySejahtera Application.
